CIVIL MARRIAGE CEREMONY #5

Officiant:

It must be done with respect, consideration and a deep and gentle caring for one another.

By your presence, you celebrate with them the love they have discovered in each other and you support their decision to commit themselves to one another for the rest of their lives.

The Expression of Intent:

Officiant to Celebrant 1:

You have chosen Celebrant 2 to be your life partner. Will you love and respect him/her? Will you be honest with him/her always? Will you stand by him/her through whatever may come? *Celebrant 1:* I will.

Officiant to Celebrant 2:

You have chosen Celebrant 1 to be your life partner. Will you love and respect him/her? Will you be honest with him/her always? Will you stand by him/her through whatever may come?

Celebrant 2: I will.

Officiant:

And do you both promise to make the necessary adjustments in your personal lives in order that you may live in a harmonious relationship, together? *Celebrant 1 & Celebrant 2:* We do.

Officiant to Celebrant 1: Please repeat after me.

"I, Celebrant 1, do solemnly declare / that I do not know / of any lawful impediment / why I may not be joined in matrimony / to Celebrant 2."

Officiant to Celebrant 2: Please repeat after me.

"I, Celebrant 2, do solemnly declare / that I do not know / of any lawful impediment / why I may not be joined in matrimony / to Celebrant 1"

The Exchange of Vows:

Officiant

Celebrant 1 and Celebrant 2, now we come to your vows. May I remind you that saying your vows here today is one thing but nothing is more challenging than living them day by day.

Officiant to Celebrant 1: Please repeat after me:

"In the presence of our family and friends / I, Celebrant 1, choose you, Celebrant 2, / to be my life partner / to have and to hold / from this day forward / for better and for worse, / for richer or for poorer, / in sickness and in health, / in joy and in

sorrow, / to love and to cherish, / and to be faithful to you alone. / This is my solemn vow.

Officiant to Celebrant 2: Please repeat after me:

"In the presence of our family and friends / I, Celebrant 2, choose you, Celebrant 1, / to be my life partner / to have and to hold / from this day forward / for better and for worse, / for richer or for poorer, / in sickness and in health, / in joy and in sorrow, / to love and to cherish, / and to be faithful to you alone. / This is my solemn vow.

Officiant to Celebrant 1: Please repeat after me.

"I call upon these persons here present / to witness that I, Celebrant 1, / do take you, Celebrant 2, / to be my lawful wedded _____."

Officiant to Celebrant 2: Please repeat after me. "I call upon these persons here present / to witness that I, Celebrant 2, / do take you, Celebrant 1, / to be my lawful wedded _____."

The Giving and Receiving of Rings:

Officiant: May I have the rings, please.

Officiant to Celebrant 1: Please repeat after me:

"Celebrant 2, I give you this ring / that you may wear it / as a symbol of the vows we have made this day. / I pledge you my love and respect, / my laughter and tears / and with all that I am, I honour you."

Officiant to Celebrant 2: Please repeat after me:

"Celebrant 1, I give you this ring / that you may wear it / as a symbol of the vows we have made this day. / I pledge you my love and respect, / my laughter and tears / and with all that I am, I honour you."

Officiant:

Now may those who wear these rings live in love all of their lives. Now may the love which has brought you together continue to grow and enrich your lives. May you continue to meet with courage any problems that may arise to challenge you. May your relationship always be one of love and trust. May the happiness that you share today be with you always and may everything that you have said and done here today become a living truth in your lives.

Celebrant 1 and Celebrant 2, we have heard your promise to share your lives in marriage. We recognize and respect the covenant you have made here this day before each one of us as witnesses. Therefore, in the honesty and sincerity of what you have said and done here today I, *Officiant*. by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Marriage Act, do hereby pronounce you married and partners in life....for life.
